Old Friendship (Guyther) Barn

Possibly of a 17th century construction date, this small barn is believed to be the earliest domestic dependency standing in Southern Maryland. It was moved to this site several years ago and is undergoing a painstaking restoration by its present owner.

The one-story central block is believed to have contained a small mill and grain shed on the first floor and two separate storage areas on the second (attic) level. An interesting feature retained on the interior is the use of curved braces supporting a central tie beam. Shed additions at each side are of 19th century date.
