The property currently known as the Price Stock Farm was sold by John Ridgely to Philip Warble in 1789 and it appears that the house was constructed soon thereafter. The property remained in the Warble and Wagner families until 1912, when it was sold to the Lemmons who owned the farm until 1954. The house is a rectangular-shaped brick structure covered in stucco. The main facade is four bays wide with asymmetrical fenestration which suggests that the structure was built in two sections. Other features of the house, such as the sash windows and double-tiered porch on the rear, are later alterations to this early Federal period structure.
