**3432 Uniontown Road**

**3432 Uniontown Road** has many characteristics of a late nineteenth century dwelling. However, a brick building stood on this lot in 1837 that probably was constructed prior to that date. The property was purchased by John Gore from Isaiah Pearce in 1837 and remained in the Gore family until 1932, so it is impossible to determine anything from the land records about the history of the building during those years. The land records provide evidence that a house stood on this property as early as 1837 through a deed for an adjoining property that states the lot at 3432 Uniontown Road was occupied by John Gore. The 1837 tax assessment lists a brick house on this lot assessed to Isaiah Pearce. The current house contains a number of late nineteenth century features, such as the stretcher bond brick facade, the tall two-over-two window sash, and the three-sided bay window and side porch on the west facade. The one-story, one-bay entrance porch is of a design identical to the side porch. The large, central chimney is from a recent remodeling. The house was bought in 1932 by the Uniontown Church of God for their use as a parsonage, and it remained in their ownership until 1979.

This is a brick dwelling with the walls laid in a common bond. At the 1st level S. front are 5 bays: center door flanked by 2 windows at each side. 5 windows are at the 2nd floor level.

at the W. end wall is a two story bay window with a portico styled porch extending out from the 1st. floor level W. end.

To the front door is a shallow portico with a small decorative balcony at its roof.

It appears that there is a full cellar and that the 1st level E front window was once a door since bricked in to form a window.

Two well shaped trees (Maple) shade the front wall (S. elevation).

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The "Horner House" is a brick dwelling with the walls laid in a common bond. At the S. elevation (front) at the 1st. floor level are 5 "bays", viz: a centered door flanked by two six over 6 sash windows at ea. side. There are also 5 openings (all windows) at the second floor level.

at the S. end elevation is a 2 story bay window with an elongated portico of one story running in a westerly direction from that.

Decorating an otherwise simple facade is a shallow portico at the front door. This portico possesses a decorative "balcony" at its roof level.

It appears that there is a full cellar and that the 1st. level & front window was originally a door and since bricked in and framed to contain a window.

Two well shaped and healthy maple trees shade the S. front wall.
