CARR-222 Charles Haines House

The house at **3212 Uniontown Road** appears to have been built between 1877 and 1881 by Charles Haines. The property was sold to Haines by George Harris for \$5.00 in 1875, and the house is not shown on the 1877 Atlas. In 1881, Haines sold the property to Jesse T. H. Davis for \$200. The gable-front structure on this property appears to date from the early twentieth century.


