CARR-225 John B. Williams House

This property and several properties on the north side of Uniontown Road were involved in an equity court case in 1875, to settle the estate of John B. Williams, who is shown living at **3201 Uniontown Road** on the 1862 Martenet's Map. Williams had purchased the lot for \$100 in 1829, and had developed a substantial farmstead on the property. The court papers give the following description: "a log house with a back building attached, a well of excellent water with a pump near the door, a very superb cave built upon the most scientific plan, and all other necessary outbuildings together with a new bank barn 30 by 45 feet." The Cover family bought the property in 1877, and the house as it stands today dates from their ownership.


