CARR-226 Dennis Chaise House

This property is referred to as the "Dennis Chaise" property in the land records, and it appears that Chaise, a black man, constructed the first structure at **3309 Uniontown Road** in the mid-nineteenth century. The Lewis A. Smith and William H. Baker families lived here during the late nineteenth century. Prices in the land records indicate that the property was greatly improved during the early twentieth century.


