CARR-227 Anna Hays House

The property at **3313 Uniontown Road** was sold by George Harris to Ephraim Wilson for \$50 in 1854. In 1859, Wilson erected the house and sold it to a black woman, Anna Hays of Baltimore City, for \$350. After Anna Hays's death, the property was owned by Annie Parker Reister, who sold it to Jesse T.H. Davis. In 1896, Dr. Jacob J. Weaver, Jr., bought the property from Davis's estate for his black caretaker Edward Lewis and his wife, Elizabeth, who was Weaver's housekeeper. The Lewis family owned the property until 1956.


