1775 Stone Chapel Road is a mid-nineteenth century house that was greatly altered in the late nineteenth century to its present rural Victorian style appearance. This remodeling included the construction of a two-and-one-half story, gable-front addition which has a two story bay window with a projecting gabled dormer. The dormer has a diamond-shaped window that echos the style and design of a dormer constructed at the center of the main section of the house. The three-bay, one-story front porch has recently been enclosed. The asymmetrical character of the house is typical of the Victorian period and this structure is a good example of rural Victorian features.
