

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two and one-half story frame house is four bays wide by two bays deep, and rests on a low stone foundation facing north. The building is clad in novelty siding, with corrugated metal covering its gable roof. Two entrances are centered in the principal facade, with a 2/2 sash window occupying each of the out-lying bays. A porch, now removed, extended across the full width of the facade. On the second story, four 2/2 windows are aligned over the first-floor openings. Both gables have two 2/2 windows on each story, and two small 2/2 windows lighting the attic. Interior brick chimneys exit from the peaks of the gables. A narrow two-story ell, also with an interior end chimney, extends to the rear from the southwest corner of the building.
