From its exterior characteristics, 1147 Old Manchester Road portrays an early house type from which the regional farmhouse style evolved. It has a rectangular floor plan and a long horizontal profile. The centrally located chimney, if original, represents some form of a two room plan in the house. These plans are usually of Germanic derivation. The house as it stands today shows some, but not extensive, remodeling with its full-length, one-story, partially-enclosed porch and asphalt siding.


