1600 Washington Road illustrates a number of features that were popular in domestic architecture of the early twentieth century. Foremost is the use of concrete block as a building material--in this example a rusticated block is used. The styling of the house is also representative of the period--its square, box-like shape, the hipped roof with shed roof dormers, and the wide, wrap-around porch. These details provide a good example of the Foursquare style.


