1221 Arnold Road departs from the regional style by its rectangular-shaped plan. The house appears to be built in two sections, with the oldest section being log construction. The exterior is currently covered in asphalt siding. The stone foundation, proportions, plan, and fenestration are all characteristics that are a frequently found variation on the regional style.


