1049 Poole Road is a good example of the Victorian style farmhouse in Carroll County. It retains the basic characteristics of the regional farmhouse in its form and fenestration. Its Victorian period features include the gabled dormer, full-length porch on columns, and main entrance with transom and sidelights. The house appears to have been built by the same family that lived at 1045 Poole Road during the late nineteenth century.


