An example of a house and store combination is shown in the frame structure at 7574 Middleburg Road. The regional house type is altered from its five-bay appearance to provide for a storefront with a separate entrance and a gable-front design with ornamental pointed-arch window. This example has a full-length porch with a one-story, three-sided bay window in the westernmost bay. This building is shown in the 1877 Atlas of Carroll County, Maryland as the store and post office of W. H. Renner.


