The Democratic Advocate Saturday, April 16, 1898



"The elevator and warehouse at Double Pipe Creek, owned by Calvin B. Anders and leased by J. Wright Barrick, was burned last Monday morning. The fire was discovered in the roof of the building about 10 o'clock and it is thought that it originated from a spark from an engine on the Western Maryland Railroad. The flames spread to a lumberyard nearby and considerable lumber was destroyed. With the warehouse and elevator were burned also machinery, straw, hay, feed, etc. The building was comparatively new. The loss is estimated at about \$10,000 and there was insurance of \$3,000 on the building and machinery for Calvin B. Anders, executor, and \$3,000 on the contents for J. Wright Barrick, all in the James E. Smith Agency, Westminster."

The American Sentinel of the same date has a somewhat longer article about the insurance and damage, etc. About the building, it states, "this building replaced a mill destroyed by fire several years ago."
