Summary:

The house at 2566 Mayberry Road is located near the village of Mayberry and probably had a very close connection with it. The house does not appear on the 1877 atlas and was probably constructed in the 1890's. The 1917 map indicates that it was the home of William H. Halter. It is a very plain, simple structure that probably always had the central door set a little off-center. It has a great deal in common with the house nearby at 2645 Robert Arthur Road (CARR-1417).

The house at 2566 Mayberry Road is located about 4½ miles east of Taneytown in northwestern Carroll County, Maryland. It is a two-story, three-bay structure, and faces east toward Mayberry Road. It has a parged foundation, aluminum siding, a gable roof with standing-seam metal, and an interior brick chimney on the south. The east elevation on the first story has, from north to south, a 2/2 double-hung sash, a new door set south of center, and a 2/2 sash. There is a two-bay porch with a shed roof and new posts and decking. The porch covers approximately the two northern bays. The second story has a 2/2 sash in each end bay with no opening in the center bay.

The south elevation on the first story has two 2/2 sash. The second story has a 2/2 sash in the east bay. The gable end has a four-light sash set to the east of the chimney. There is an ell on the west elevation. The south elevation of the ell has altered openings. The north elevation of the main block of the house has a new exterior chimney with a single 2/2 sash set east of it on both the first and second stories. The gable end has a vent east of the chimney. The north elevation of the ell has one 2/2 sash on both the first and second stories.






