Point of Rocks Methodist Episcopal Church is a three-bay-wide, four-bay-deep, front-gabled, frame building constructed in 1894. The aluminum-sided structure rests atop a solid, sandstone ashlar foundation. A transom surmounts the central double-leaf doors. All of the 2/2 hung windows are wood Queen Anne sashes with multicolored glass panes. The roof is clad in the original slate. A brick interior chimney laid in stretcher bond is located in the west elevation. The small steeple features sawn ornament. A low, gable-roofed concrete block addition is adjacent to the north elevation.

The Point of Rocks survey district (F-1-187) was evaluated for eligibility for listing in the National Register for the purpose of a FEMA acquisition. It was determined ineligible for inclusion due to lack of integrity. No structures were individually evaluated at that time. JMA evaluated the Methodist Episcopal Church as part of the Marc Train Parking Lot Expansion project. The church was built in 1894 on the site of an earlier church, which dated to 1867. Currently the church is home to the Christian Life Fellowship. The church does not appear to be associated with people or events of local, regional or national significance; thus it does not appear to meet the criteria A or B. Architecturally, the building is a typical modest late-nineteenth century vernacular Victorian design which lacks the design, workmanship, and integrity to qualify it as eligible for listing under criterion C.



Originally built in 1867, and rebuilt in 1894, the Point of Rocks United Methodist Church exhibits the frame construction and detailing popular in the 1890's.

The church is a 2½ story frame covered with aluminum siding chapel, three bays wide and four bays deep. Double hung multiple colored pane and etched glass windows occupy the bays. Flanking the gable in the front center is a frame belfry with fishscale slate roof, pierced frame railing and bell. The entire building is surrounded by an ornate cast iron fence.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Point of Rocks United Methodist Church is a two and one-half story frame covered with aluminum siding, church which faces south from the north side of Route 28 in Point of Rocks.

The principle facade is three bays wide. Twin arched paneled doors with nine light transom in a recessed paneled entrance, are located in the second bay. Double hung multiple colored pane and etched glass windows are located in the remaining bays on the first and second level. Small pedimented entablatures are located in each bay on the second level and the windows in the south gable which are smaller twin windows, identical to those on the first and second level. A plain solid bargeboard is located in the north and south gables.

The entire structure is built on a low red quarried stone foundation and is surrounded by a decorative cast iron fence. One gate of the fence is taken from "Page Number 115, 36."

The front gable patterned slate roof is attached to the building by a plain cornice with overhanging roof. Flanking the gable in the front center is a frame belfry with fishscale slate roof pierced frame railing and bell.

A small one story cinder block addition has been added to the rear of the structure.


