DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#16 is a two story brick building detached on the right (W) side, four bays wide and three bays in depth with a full width, three bay deep, frame extension. The front is covered by stucco and the extension is of board and batten siding and shingles. The shop door and window occupies the left bays and second story front windows are of 2/2 sash with wood lintels and sills. The front section roof slopes to the rear. This building sets on a low foundation.
