DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#10 is a very small, 2-1/2 story detached house, two bays square with a newer, two story, long frame warehouse extension. The front facade is in common bond brick with the rest apparently being frame, now covered with a brick design asphalt sheathing. The simple doorway occupies the left bay with a newer door and narrow overlight. A side door is of four panels. The few windows are mostly now of 1/1 sash with a 6/6 sash on the side. Front windows and the door are headed by flat brick arches. The front section has a steep slope metal roof with a two string brick cornice on the front. There are no apparent chimneys. This house rests on a low fieldstone foundation.




