DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>Saint Anne's Church stands on the westerly side of the Avilton-Lonaconing Road in the Walnut Hill area of northern Garrett County, east of Grantsville.</p> <p>The church is a one and a half story frame "country" Gothic structure with a bell and entrance tower on the south end and a two and a half story attachment on the north end. The line of the gable roof runs north/south. The main portion of the structure consists of three sections with what is probably the oldest in the center. The south section, which has the entrance and bell tower attached to it is on a stone foundation similar to the center building. A seam is clearly visible between these sections. The north section has a small basement under it. The entire building is covered with clapboards and has six bays along each side. A cornerstone with 1872 on it is in the southeast corner of the foundation. The interior consists of a large nave, recently renovated, the length of most of the principal portion of the building. The north or back end has two stories with small rooms for storage and offices.</p> <p>The building is structurally sound.</p> <p>The Parish Hall is a one and a half story clapboard covered frame structure with the main entrance in the east gable wall.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>Saint Anne's Church is characteristic of the late nineteenth century frame Gothic style ecclesiastical structures commonly found in the rural regions of western Maryland. Now used only for special occasions, Saint Anne's once was the community center for the Roman Catholic population of northeastern Garrett County.</p> <p>The earliest portion, believed to be the center section of the nave, was built about 1872. The north and south additions enlarging the nave were probably erected about the turn of the twentieth century. The interior of the nave was renovated with new trim, altar, benches, etc. in the 1960s.</p> <p>The Parish Hall appears to have been built in the early 1900s.</p>


