The house measures three bays by two bays and rests on a stone foundation. Its symmetrically arranged three bay, center door facade is sheltered by a full length porch, and all elevations are lit by 4/4 sash windows. Unfortunately, this dwelling has been severely altered.

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**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Harry Hummel House is a frame, two story, gabled-roofed building with a modern 1½ story gable-roofed addition on the rear. The house measures three bays wide by two bays deep and rests on a coursed, roughly squared stone foundation. Its symmetrically arranged three bay, center door facade is sheltered by a full length porch that has been remodeled. The small gable-roofed projection on the facade second floor, center bay is not original. All windows are 4/4 sash. The window surrounds and any decorative trim that may have been present were removed when the house was covered with aluminum siding. The box cornice has also been obscured by aluminum siding.
