

The Gale A. Kamp Farm on Avilton-Lonaconing Road is a side gable, two-story, frame house constructed ca.1900. The house has a stone foundation. The side gable roof is covered with asphalt shingles. The windows have been replaced and a large picture widow has been added to the front façade. A shed roof side porch has been added.

The house is a common vernacular twentieth century building that lacks distinction. The building's integrity has been compromised through additions and alterations that reduce its integrity (materials, design, workmanship). The property does not appear to be eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.
