## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Raymond C. Bender House is located on the E side of Collier Road, in the vicinity of Bear Creek. The house is surrounded by rolling fields.

The house is a one and ½-story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points SE. The ground slopes down from SE to NW, creating a basement story at the rear of the house. A one-story, shed-roofed porch covers the facade and SW elevations. A one-story, shed-roofed addition on a high basement covers the NW elevation and extends beyond the main block on the SW elevation.

The house rests on a coursed stone foundation and the plank-constructed walls are covered with aluminum siding. The windows are two over two sash with plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with corrugated metal.

On the NE elevation is an exterior shouldered brick fireplace chimney, now blocked on the inside. The addition on the NW elevation rests on a cinderblock foundation. On the SW elevation, the porch rests on a foundation of ceramic blocks and has been partially enclosed.

The interior has an enclosed central staircase, but is otherwise unknown.

The site includes several modern farm buildings.


