DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Fazenbaker-Ryland House is located below Bowman Hill Road near Engle Mill. Bear Creek runs southwest of the house, feeding a small pond at the rear of the property. South of the house is a portion of the Savage River State Forest.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed structure measuring three bays across the facade. The facade points northeast. A one-story, shed-roofed porch runs the length of the facade and a one-story pantry is attached to the southeast side of the southwest elevation. A deck is also attached to the southwest elevation.

The house rests on a cut stone foundation and is covered with asphalt roll siding. Two window types are represented, sash and sliding, and several sash varieties appear, including six over two, two over two, and four over four. The central facade door has five horizontal panels. The roof is covered with asphalt rollpaper.

The house has one central cinderblock stove chimney with a brick cap. The facade porch roof is supported by four square posts and is covered with asphalt rollpaper.

The interior of the house is unknown.


