DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Harry Hachman House stands on the NE side of Old Morgantown Road, just N of U.S. Route 48. The facade points SE.

The house is a one and a half story, gable-roofed rectangular log house, measuring 18' x 24' 2". An enclosed shed porch runs the length of the facade.

The house rests on a cut stone foundation. The corners of the sills are cut in a half-dovetail notch; the rest of the logs are V-notched. All logs are daubed with concrete and a date scratched into the daubing on the NE elevation dates it July, 1965. There are two windows on the NE elevation; one four over four sash on the first floor and one six-paned square on the second story. Both are set in the center of the wall. On the NW elevation are similar windows, but offset to the W. On the SW elevation a single-paned square is set into the gable. All windows have plain board surrounds and new storm windows. The roof is covered with tar paper and corrugated metal, and the porch and gables are covered with red asphalt siding.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

According to neighbors, Amanda Brown, the mother of Harry and Edward Hachman, may have had this house and the Edward Hachman House (G-II-B-066) built. The V-notched log construction of this house is representative of an early Garrett County construction type which continued to be popular into the 19th century. Hachman or Hockman is a name found early in the history of this area.




