DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Effie Georg House is located at the end of Lawrence George Road, approximately two miles NW of Accident. The house is surrounded by rolling fields.

The house is a one and one-half story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points SE. A shed-roofed addition covers the NW elevation and a shed-roofed porch covers the facade and the SW gable end.

The house rests on a rough cut stone foundation and is covered with german siding. The windows are two over two sash except for the facade, where the windows are double one over one sash. All windows have plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with standing seam metal.

The rear addition extends beyond both gable ends and its roof forms a catslide with the roof of the main block. The addition is covered with german siding and has two over two sash windows except for the SW window on the exposed cellar story, which is a six over six sash window. According to the tenant, all the windows were originally six over six sash. The house's one stove chimney emerges from the roof of the addition just NE of center.

The porch on the SW gable end has been enclosed. On the facade, the porch is supported by chamfered posts.

The house includes a frame bank barn and a frame spring house, both covered with vertical boards.


