The Jennings United Methodist Church is a one-story, gable-roofed building covered with modern, randomly coursed, cut sandstone. The windows are five over four sash lancets and the roof is covered with blue corrugated metal. The facade points north.

The church measures four bays by one bay and has a hipped-roof apse on the south gable end. Attached to the east elevation is a shed roofed addition. On the facade is a bell tower covered with aluminum siding with a pyramidal roof.

## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Jennings United Methodist Church is located just W of the Church of God (G-II-C-088) on Hare Hollow Road near Jennings.

The church is a one-story, gable-roofed building covered with modern, randomly coursed, cut sandstone. The windows are five over four sash lancets and the roof is covered with blue corrugated metal. The facade points N.

The church measures four bays by one bay and has a hipped roof apse on the S gable end. Attached to the E elevation is a shed roofed addition. On the facade is a bell tower covered with aluminum siding with a pyramidal roof.

At the NW corner is a small marble cornerstone. On the north face the inscription reads "M.E. Church, July 1909, presented by J.B. Williams Co., Marble and Granite Dealers, Frostburg, MD." On the W face the inscription reads "L. Plummer and Son, Builder."

The church has been considerably altered and lacks architectural integrity.




