**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly area on Rt. 40 approx. 2 miles west of Grantsville. The house faces north. It is a two-story, three bay by two bay structure with a gable roof. A single story shed addition extends across the rear, south, elevation. A single story addition extends off the west end of the first addition one bay past the house. A porch, supported by large square grooved wooden posts covers the facade and the west elevation ending at the second addition. The house can be entered from the central facade entrance with transom, the rear shed addition, and from the second addition at the porch.

Interior gable end brick chimneys are located to each end of the house. A large picture with top light is located to each side of the facade entrance. The cellar can be entered from the enclosure under the facade porch. The house rests on a stone foundation. Asbestos shingles cover the exterior with diamond-shaped asphalt shingles on the roof.

A barn and other outbuildings are located on the other side of Rt. 40 north of the house.


