This two-story frame farmhouse exhibits three bays on the east facade, and four bays on the rear. An open porch crosses the facade, and an enclosed porch covers the rear. A two-story, two-bay addition abuts the north end of the rear porch, and overlaps half of the main building's north end.

A dinner bell protected by a gabled belfry tops the roof. Turned posts and a simple balustrade embellish the front porch. A springhouse, barn, and several sheds are located east and south of the house.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame farmhouse exhibits three bays on the east facade, and four bays on the rear. An open porch crosses the facade, and an enclosed porch covers the rear. A two-story, two-bay addition abuts the north end of the rear porch, and overlaps half of the main building's north end. The addition's south porch abuts the remainder of the north end.

Parallel gable roofs cap the structure's two sections. In either part of the house, two brick chimneys heat the interior. A spring emerging to the rear of the house flows through the cellar.

Six by six windows light the house. The building stands on a stone foundation and is covered with aluminum German siding. Corrugated metal covers the roof. A central door opens on the facade. A dinner bell protected by a gabled belfry tops the roof. Turned posts and a simple balustrade embellish the front porch.

A springhouse, barn, and several sheds are located east and south of the house.

A log barn was torn down in this century, and some of its members were incorporated in the construction of the present barn.


