DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Dolan House is located on the E side of Hoyes-Sang Run Road, about a quarter mile S of Hoyes. The house is surrounded by trees.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points W and is covered by a one-story, hipped-roofed storm porch. A one-story, gable-roofed addition is attached to the E elevation.

The house is covered with asphalt roll siding and has two over two and one over one sash windows. The roof is covered with tarpaper. The house has one exterior cinderblock stove chimney on the S gable end. The interior consists of two rooms and a central staircase.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

According to the present owners, this house was built as a granary, and was then used as a barn. The owner just previous to the present owners turned the structure into a house. Despite its checkered history, the house still exhibits certain features, such as the rectangular main block and rear wing, which typify western Maryland architecture of the late 19th and early 20th centuries.


