DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly semi-wooded area off Rt. 495 approximately 1½ miles north of North Glade Road. The house faces north. It is a story-and-half, four-bay by two-bay structure with a gable roof, gable end front, that slopes down to a single story at the west elevation.

A porch, supported by round wooden columns with square balustrades, covers the three (west end) facade bays. A small gable end facade porch is located on the rear, south, elevation. Entrances are located at both of these porches at the far west ends.

Two interior brick chimneys are located below the gable ends on the west elevation of the roof.

The house is lit predominantly by 6/6 sash windows with six-pane windows in the second story. The center facade window is a three-pane single sash window. Plain flat boards frame the windows.

The house rests on what appears to be a poured concrete foundation.

Park stained wooden shingles cover the house, with tar paper on the west elevation and on the roof.

Numerous outbuildings are included on the property.
