DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is situated among hemlocks in a hilly area on Rock Lodge Road. The house faces west. It is a two story, three-bay by two-bay structure with a gable roof. A single story shed addition runs the length of the rear, east elevation. A wooden porch, supported by chamfered posts, extends across the facade. The house is entered from the central facade and rear entrances with transoms.

The house has an interior glazed-brick chimney at each gable end. 2/2 sash windows light the house. The windows are framed with flat boards with drip cap window heads. Diamond-shaped asphalt shingles cover the house, with seamed metal sheets on the roof.

A single story, two-bay by one-bay gable roof structure, gable end front, is located in front of the main house. This small, German sided structure with a basement has a gable end glazed-brick chimney. 6/6 sash windows, framed with flat boards, light the house.

The house rests on a concrete foundation and is covered with German siding.


