DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The John Holtschneider Farm is located on the east side of King's Run Road, about 1/2 mile north of the intersection of King's Run, Spring Glade, and Oakland-Deer Park Roads. The farm consists of a house and a barn.

The house is a two-story, pyramid-roofed dwelling with a three-bay center-door facade. The facade points southwest and is covered by a one-story, hipped-roofed enclosed porch which also covers the southeast elevation. A gable-roofed ell extends from the southeast elevation of the main block and a shed-roofed porch covers its northeast elevation.

The house rests on a rock-faced concrete block foundation and is covered with asbestos shingle. The windows are 1/1 sash and have plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with standing seam metal and displays gabled dormers on the SW and NE elevations of the main block.

The house has three brick stove chimneys. Two are interior chimneys, one on the NW and one on the SE elevations of the main block. The third is an exterior chimney on the NE elevation of the ell. The interior plan of the house is unknown.

Northeast of the house is a gambrel-roofed frame bank barn. The bank entrance points northeast. A modern silo is attached to the southwest elevation.


