The George W. Moon House is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The house rests on a cut, squared stone foundation and is covered with asbestos shingle.

West of the house is a gable-roofed log springhouse. The logs are half-dovetail notched and the roof is covered with corrugated metal.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The George W. Moon House is located on the north side of Upperman Road, about a mile and three-quarters east of Boiling Spring Road. The site consists of the dwelling and a log springhouse.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points south and is covered by a one-story, hipped-roofed porch. The sides of the T are filled with shed-roofed, one-story additions.

The house rests on a cut, squared stone foundation and is covered with asbestos shingle. The windows are two over two sash and all surrounds have been obscured. The facade door is offset to the west.

The roof is covered with standing seam metal. The house has two exterior cinderblock stove chimneys, one on the east gable end and one on the north gable end. The facade porch roof is covered with standing seam metal and is supported by turned posts embellished with jigsaw brackets. The interior arrangement of the house is unknown.

West of the house is a gable-roofed log springhouse. The logs are half-dovetail notched and the roof is covered with corrugated metal. The entrance is on the north gable end.


