**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Ardith Wiles House is located north of Smouse Road, about a mile southeast of Loch Lynn. The house is set at the end of a dirt driveway and is surrounded by trees.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points south and is covered by a one-story, hipped-roofed porch. Above the porch, a one-story, gabled ell extends from the facade. A one story, shed-roofed enclosed porch covers the east and north elevations of the T.

The house rests on a stone foundation and is covered by asbestos shingles. The windows are 2/2 sash and have plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles.

The house has three brick stove chimneys, two are interior chimneys at the east and west gable ends of the main block, and an exterior chimney is placed at the corner of the main block and the T on the west elevation.

The facade porch roof is supported by square posts. The interior arrangement of the house is unknown.


