DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Stine-Byers Farm is located about a quarter mile NE off Boiling Spring Road, about one and a quarter mile SE of Deer Park. The farm consists of a house, a log barn, and a small springhouse.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points south and is covered by a one-story, shed-roofed porch. The ell, on the east and north elevations, is filled by a one-story, hipped-roofed porch.

The house rests on a stone foundation and is covered by asphalt roll siding. The windows are 2/2 sash and the surrounds have been obscured. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles.

The house has one interior brick stove chimney on the east elevation of the ell. The facade porch roof is supported by square posts. The interior arrangement of the house is unknown.


