**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Don Mason House is located on the northeast side of Smouse Road, about three quarters of a mile southeast of Loch Lynn. The house is set back from the road and is backed by fields.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a four-bay facade. The facade points southwest and the T extends from the southwest elevation. The facade is covered with a one-story, shed-roofed porch. The northeast elevation is covered with a one-story, shed-roofed porch which has been enclosed on the southeast end.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles. The windows are 1/1 sash and have plain board surrounds. The facade door has a single-paned transom. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and the box cornice returns on the gable ends.

The house has three stove chimneys. Two interior brick chimneys are positioned on the NW and SE elevations of the T, while an exterior cinder block chimney is positioned on the NW elevation of the enclosed rear porch.

The facade porch roof is supported by turned posts. The interior plan consists of our rooms. The south corner room is a large entrance hall with a single-run, panelled staircase of chestnut wood.


