The Melvin R. Custer House is a two story, gable-roofed building of balloon frame construction. Its basic configuration is a 5 bay by 2 bay rectangular plan with a full facade porch. Two four-panel doors topped by two-pane transom lights occupy the southern and central bays of the facade. The endwalls both have two windows per floor, evenly spaced, and a small square window in the gable. The rear has a symmetrical, three bay arrangement. The structure rests on a foundation of coursed, roughly squared flat stones that is topped by a plain board watertable with a slated drip board. German siding with corner-boards covers the exterior walls. All windows are 2 over 2 sash with plain board surrounds and simple drip moldings. Two interior brick stove chimneys are located at opposite ends of the ridgeline.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Melvin R. Custer House is located on the west side of Spring Lick Road approximately .2 mile south of its junction with Mellinger Road. It is situated about .1 mile back from the road with its facade pointing east.

The house is a two story, gable-roofed building of balloon frame construction. Its basic configuration is a 5 bay by 2 bay rectangular plan with a full facade porch. Two four-panel doors topped by two-pane transom lights occupy the southern and central bays of the facade. The endwalls (S and N elevations) both have two windows per floor, evenly spaced, and a small square window in the gable. The rear (W elevation) has a symmetrical, three bay arrangement.

The structure rests on a foundation of coursed, roughly squared flat stones that is topped by a plain board watertable with a slanted drip board. German siding with cornerboards covers the exterior walls. All windows are 2 over 2 sash with plain board surrounds and simple drip moldings. The roof is covered with corrugated metal and has boxed rafter ends with a plain board frieze below. Two interior brick stove chimneys with a stringcourse at the base and three course corbel caps are located at opposite ends of the ridgline. The facade porch rests on stone footings and has six chamfered posts supporting its shed roof.

A stone lined spring is situated east of the house.




