The Gas Station and Store is typical of early gas stations which included a small general store and residence for the owner/operator.

The one-story building is frame, measuring four bays by three bays with a double entrance and gable roof. The facade faces NW towards Route 219. There is a one-story frame shed wing at the rear, SE elevation. A large proportioned gable roofed porch runs across the facade and extends beyond the walls of the main block, designed to accommodate the gas pumps and gasoline customers.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Gas Station and Store is located on Route 219 at the West Virginia state line. It is typical of early gas stations which included a small general store and residence for the owner/operator. It also features a large porch/drive-through for gasoline customers.

The one-story building is frame, measuring four bays by three bays with a double entrance and gable roof. The facade faces NW towards Route 219. There is a one-story frame shed wing at the rear, SE elevation. A large proportioned gable roofed porch runs across the facade and extends beyond the walls of the main block, designed to accomodate the gas pumps and gasoline customers.

The main block and wing are covered with german siding. The roofs are covered with tarpaper. The foundation of the main block is concrete; the wing is supported by wooden piers. The facade porch roof is frame, covered with tarpaper and features a central, gable roofed, dormer at the front. The porch is supported by six panel-faced concrete building block piers and posts.

Windows are sash; the facade windows, on either side of the double entrance, are large 2/2 sash storefront windows.

There are two interior brick chimneys one in the main block and one in the kitchen wing.

The structure is presently unoccupied.

A concrete-cast MD-WV boundary stone stands approximately 100 feet west of the building. The inscription at the middle of the SE face reads, "No. 6"; at the base of the same side it reads, "Samuel S. Cannett/W. McCulloh Brown/Julius K. Monroe." The NW face reads, "1910." The SW and NE faces read "WVA" and "MD" respectively.




Table Rock; MD:WV
