## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly semi-wooded area on Oak Grove Road approximately 1/2 mile south of Route 560. The house faces south. It is a two story, three bay by two bay cross gable roof structure. A porch, supported by knobbed and turned wooden posts and balustrades, with brackets, runs the length of the facade. A single story shed addition runs across the east elevation. The section to the front is an enclosed porch. This shed addition continues around and extends the length of the rear north elevation. The house can be entered from the central facade entrance, entrances to the enclosed porch at the facade and east elevations and an entrance on the shed addition also at the east elevation.

The house has a central brick chimney. One over one sash windows light the house. Single pane windows are located in the gables. The stone cellar is entered from under the facade porch. Vinyl siding covers the original weatherboard siding. Asphalt shingles cover the roof. The house rests on a stone foundation.

A barn as well as other outbuildings are located on the property.


