## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly area on US Route 50 approximately 1¼ miles southwest of Gorman. The house faces northeast. It is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a gable end facade. The house has a two bay by one bay ell. A single story shed addition is located on the rear southwest elevation of the main block. The house can be entered from this addition, a small porch at the southeast elevation of the ell and from the central facade entrance done in colonial revival.

The house has a central brick chimney. Modern two over two windows have been installed with a large picture window on the first floor north side facade. In the gable end facade is an arched two over two sash window. The house rests on a stone foundation. Aluminum siding covers the original weatherboard siding. Weatherboard is still located in the gable ends. Corrugated metal covers the roof.

A frame barn is also located on the property.
