The only changes that have been made to to the exterior of this building since the 1975 survey appear to be the addition of one-over-one double-hung aluminum storm windows throughout. In addition, an open-sided pyramidal-roofed frame outbuilding now stands on the northeast side of the house. There are no other visible outbuildings. The main building, which is still used as a dwelling, is currently occupied and remains in excellent condition.

<p>134 North Second Street in Oakland, Garrett County, stands on the west side of the street, near the entersection of Crook Street.</p> <p>The house is a mid-late nineteenth century frame structure, presently covered with aluminum siding, of two and a half stories, with a low gable roof, a symmetrical facade (east side) of three bays, and flanking one story side wings (probably new). The main entranceway has rectangular sidelights and transom.</p> <p>The building is structurally sound. It was converted for apartments in recent years.</p>

<b>STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE</b>  <p style="margin-left: 40px;">134 North Second Street is representative of the mid-late nineteenth century domestic architecture of Oakland and the surrounding area. The strong influence of the classical styles, particularly the Greek Revival, are evident in the symmetrical facade, the low roof, and the rectangular transom and sidelights at the entrance.</p>


