



The house at 105 North Second Street retains most of its original late-nineteenth-century exterior. The two-story five-bay frame dwelling with a two-story rear ell is in very good condition. Well maintained by its current owners, it has recently been repainted. The only visible alterations not noted when it was surveyed in 1975 are the replacement of two second-story windows with one-over-one double-hung sash wooden windows.

The property includes a two-car garage at its southeast corner. Clad in wooden drop siding, this frame building has a front-facing gable roof sheathed with asphalt shingles. It faces south towards Pennington Street.

<p>105 North Second Street in Oakland, Garrett County, stands on the east side of the street at the intersection of Pennington Street, northeast corner.</p> <p>The house is a two and a half story frame structure with a low gable roof, a symmetrical facade (west side) of five bays with a center doorway, a one story frame across the front and along the south side, and a brick internal end chimney on the south end. The roof line runs north/south. A wing or ell projects from the back or east side. The principle windows are long and narrow and have double-hung wooden sashes with four-over-four lights on the second story and four-over-six lights on the first floor. The front first floor windows have louvered shutters. The main entranceway has rectangular sidelights and transom.</p> <p>The house is structurally sound and the exterior appears to be basically unaltered since erected in the late nineteenth century.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

105 North Second Street is representative of mid-late nineteenth century domestic architecture in Oakland, Garrett County. Stylistically, the building has the rectangular doorway common to the Greek Revival style and the long, narrow windows and low roof pitch that are characteristic of the Italianate period. The house is similar to several standing along East Alder Street east of Third Street. (see G-VI-008, G-VI-009, and G-VI-010 as other examples of the form)




