

A field view of 314 Second Street undertaken in January of 1997 indicated that the dwelling stands virtually unaltered since being first documented in 1970. The structure's fabric seems to suggest one building period however. The 1970 survey form indicated that the dwelling consisted of a rectangular portion facing Second Street to the west and a later, attached two-story ell. An inspection of the building does not reveal any telltale seams in the exterior brick work indicating the appending of an addition to an earlier structure nor other obvious exterior evidence to support such a supposition.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

314 Second Street, Oakland, is a substantial mid-19th century brick house of 2storeys plus attic. This is house is composed of a narrow, 3 bay, rectangular block set lengthwise to the street, and a narrow ell added at right angles on the rear at one side, thus forming an L shaped plan. The gently sloping roof is offset by a heavy molded and deep cornice; the windows have pointed molded lintels (windows are now 1/1). A porch supported by simple columns and with balusters runs across the front of the house [base of porch is recent, although house probably has always had some form of porch on the front].

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

314 Second Street is a substantial brick example of the Allegheny venacular house [see G-40], i.e. a narrow (one room deep) rectangular block with three bays, 2 storeys, and central doorway. As is usual with this type, the later wing is very much like the main section and is added to the rear, but at one side (rather than in the middle). More than just another local dwelling, 314 has a pronounced cornice and pointed molded lintels (late Greek Revival) and was probably built in the mid-19th century.


