DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small, 1½ storey cottage originally had vertical board and batten siding on all sides; this has been replaced [?] by horizontal clapboards on the front, but the sides still retain vertical siding. Built on a stone base, there is a simple porch over the central door. This is flanked by a narrow 2/2 window on either side. This three bay arrangement is repeated in the peaked dormers which run from below the cornice to 2 or 3 feet above the roof (these dormers have vertical battens). There are two small chimneys at each end of the front slope of the roof. There is a 1 storey ell attached to the rear (same age as main part of cottage).

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

22 East Liberty Street belongs in a category with 4 East Liberty Street, in that it was probably a cottage attached to one of the early resort hotels near the Oakland railroad station. It certainly is the same 'style' and is from the same architectural sources/antecedents (probably the same edition of Woodward or Downing) as 4 East Liberty. This is a smaller, less elaborate cottage. [see also 28 East Liberty]



This small 1 1/2 story ~~vertical board~~ cottage originally had vertical board + batten siding on all sides (has been replaced [?] by horizontal clapboards on front side, still on sides). Built on a stone base there is a simple porch over the central door; this is flanked by 2 narrow 3/4 windows. This 3 bay arrangement is repeated in the peaked dormers which ~~starts~~ run from below cornice ~~to~~ to a 2-3 feet above roof (these dormers have vert. batten).
