DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Parker H. Lee House is a two story, two section stone house with a stucco exterior and a two story porch which was possibly built in the late 18th or early 19th century and is located on the south side of Cool Spring Road about 1/4 mile west of Priestford Road (Maryland Route 136). The house and its related outbuildings are east of the modern development of Cool Spring in Harford County, Maryland. The main elevation of the house faces east.

The two sections of the house were probably built at different times, but the sequence of construction is not known. The present owner has been told by older residents of the area that the house dates in part from about 1780. This is difficult to verify by the visible evidence of the house, but remains a possibility.

Both sections are two stories with three bays on both the east (main) and west elevations. The sections are joined on their gable ends with the gable roof ridge on a north-south axis. Each has a side hall entry and interior end chimneys. The north section is situated on a northern slope and thus appears somewhat lower in height than the south portion. The west elevations of both sections have exposed cellars.

The southern section has a two story open porch with concrete block columns and plain balustrades. This was probably added in the mid 20th century. On the south gable end of the section is a flat-roofed polygonal two story projecting bay. This bay is frame with clapboard siding and is undoubtedly a late 19th or early 20th century addition. The slate roof has two gabled dormers facing west. The dormers have returns and fluted moldings. The north section has a small entry porch at a side door on its north end.

The windows on the first floor of the south section are 1/1, but most others are 6/6. The windows of the east elevation have louvred shutters. The roof of both sections is slate.

Several barns and other agricultural outbuildings are located south of the house. Visible across a pasture to the south is a two story frame tenant house which appears to have been built during the last quarter of the 19th century. It has three bays and a shed porch which has been partially enclosed. The roof is slate and the exterior is asbestos shingles. Two interior chimneys project from the roof.


DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Cool Spring Farm is now part of property owned by the developer of a commercial center fronting on Churchill Road. Entered now on Cool Spring Road, the ^{two story} house faces east in two parts, each ~~part~~ three bays long, two rooms deep. The ridge line runs north-south. There is a two story porch facing east on the southern section of the house, and a victorian bay window is added to the south wall, first floor.

Two large chimneys at the north wall and the central wall lead from several interior fireplaces that are blocked up.

The house has been divided into four apartments.




