DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The two and a half story frame mill stood on Deep Creek, the stream diverted into a mill wheel in the basement that ran like a carousel - the power beside the vertical hub or axle of the wheel.

The building faces south, the ridge line running north-south, doors in each of two floors and the attic floor ~~three doors~~ to receive grain hoisted up on pulleys at the peak of the eaves.

The building is very plain. Windows are 6/6, symmetrically placed. An extra door is in the west wall as the control point for letting water out of the millrace into the mill.
