STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

As in the case of St ~~Mark's~~ ^{Mark's} (HA 614) and the Friends Meeting House (HA 609) this chapel was built because commuting distances - this time to Bel Air - were too far - and "residents of the area who attended church in Bel Air were forbidden to leave their horses and carriages nearby ..."

Fallston grew twice before from the south and west, this time from the east.

Cornerstone laid in 1908. first service 18 April 1909, consecrated December 1909.
