DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This L shaped brick church with gable ends facing east and south, is over a bank basement of stone lighted on the long north side. The ~~square~~ ^{square} belfry, is in the angle of the L near the southeast corner has three stories under a square arcade of four Roman arches on each side under a hip roof topped by an eight-sided pinnacle.

The wide A roof sweeps low on all sides. Gable ends have a large round arched window (topped with a "rose" over three round arches) flanked by two smaller round-arched windows with two arches below a smaller "rose". Each has Tiffany-type stained glass.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

The first Welsh settlers in this area worshipped in the homes of their ~~neighbors~~ fellow-church-members in a settlement called Stone town (near Stateville Church). Methodist (Rehobeth) groups and Congregationalist (Bethesda) groups formed within the church ~~and~~ at West Bayton, Pa. They separated in 1852. About forty years later the present Rehobeth building was constructed. The group joined the United Presbyterians of U.S.A. in 1930. More recently they have separated again, the Rehobeth Welsh Church moving to Delta, Pa, this Presbyterian Church remaining in Maryland though associated with the Donegal Presbyterians in Pennsylvania!


