The Cianelli House is a small, one and a half story, three bay by one bay frame dwelling on a low stuccoed random rubble foundation. Covered with hewn clapboards, the house appears to have originally been one room deep with the shed roof kitchen addition and a cross gable on the front added later. This is an example of a mid-Atlantic I house, one room deep with an assymetrical two-room plan and a shed addition.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Cianelli House is a small, one-and-a-half story, three-bay by one-bay frame dwelling on a low stuccoed random rubble foundation. It is located at 800 Erie Street at the corner of Juniata St., facing north. Covered with hewn clapboards, the house is painted yellow with brown trim. Originally the house appears to have been one room deep with the shed roof kitchen addition and a cross gable on the front added later.

A three-bay porch with thin square posts and a hipped roof extends across the facade (north elevation). The wooden floor has recently been replaced with cement. On the rear a shed roof supported by two thin, square posts shelters the kitchen door on the west wall of the wing and the bulkhead on the south wall.

Windows are for the most part 6/6 light pegged sash, many having old glass in them. The window in the cross gable has 2/2 light sash and the enframent has a slight triagular curve at the top.

The entrance in the central bay of the facade has a four panel door of glass and wood.

The asphalt shingled gable flank roof has a cross gable on the front and a long slope to the east where the shed addition joins. A single chimney rises from the ground and is on the north end of the kitchen shed.

Interior:

Internally the house has an assymetrical two room plan with a kitchen wing on the rear and a staircase on the west wall.

This small dwelling, with a beautiful vegetable garden behind it and flowers surrounding it, presents a very attractive and neat appearance.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Architecturally, the house is an example of a Mid-Atlantic I house, one room in depth with an assymetrical two-room plan and a shed addition.

The house is a wonderful example for community planning of the contribution that can be made to a town by an unpretentious frame dwelling when left without modern siding so that the relationship of the original building materials to the mass and shape of the house are revealed and not obscured.

The building is thought by many to have been an early railroad station, perhaps even moved from another site.


